Flying can be decentralised for all events but note that entries can only be 'A' class on the Old Warden dates even if decentralised.

Communication by email is preferred.

Decentralised entry: inform the coordinator of intention to fly, preferably on the day before the event. The information required is name and BMFA number, name of timekeeper (if known at that stage), flying location (preferably Google Map Lat/Long), and names, power units and classes (competition or sport, A, B or C) of models.

Flying site: the chosen site must not provide slope lift. If flying abroad, use local time.

On the day of the event: fly the rounds between 10:00 am and 4:00 pm (or between 5:30 pm and 7:00 pm on a Wednesday evening). If 3 max's are achieved then make a fly-off flight at 4:00 pm (or 7:00 pm on a Wednesday evening). As soon as is possible email or text the results to the coordinator, giving motor run and flight times in seconds for each model flown. The full results for the day will then be circulated by the coordinator.

Scoring for the Tasuma Trophy: the best results from two thirds (rounded to the nearest whole number) of the qualifying events will count towards the series. A qualifying event is an event which has 3 or more flyers.

For each event the 1st place score = number of entries
2nd place score = number of entries minus 1
etc
last place score = 1
not flown score = 0

If there is a tie for the series then the number of first places will be considered. If there is still a tie then the number of 2nd places will be considered, etc.
