SAM 35 will run an All-In Precision comp, plus under 25” Vintage Rubber. Peterborough Club will hold a “members only” E20 demonstration contest and Cloud Tramp. Also, the Scale boys will be there for a flying only contest.

September 9th...not strictly SAM 35, but the **Peterborough Flying Aces** contest will be at Ferry Meadows, as usual. A significant social meeting as well as having a wide range of small model classes and a great atmosphere.

September 23rd...the second annual running of the “**Rubber Bowden**” event at Old Warden. Ensure to enter before noon, to go into the ballot for running order. Last year this was the most successful event of the calendar.

By then, two postal events will have begun: The “**Lulu and Friends**” (three classes, a wide range of gliders, some towed, some by Hi-Start, see elsewhere on the website)and also the **P30 “Area Postal”** at 7th Area , 8th Area or any Rally or Gala in between, which rounds off our season.
