

Additional Notes for “Three Day Precision” Event

(Please read this in conjunction with “All-In Precision.”)

Flights may be made at any time between 10.00am and 8pm on the first and second days, and between 10.00am and 4pm on the third.

Awards will be prepared on the final day, but are likely to be a Trophy for first and Certificates for class wins, subject to the number of competitors in each class.

An additional award will be presented to the best score with a model powered by a SAM 35 or SAM 50 motor.

For the £3 entry fee, a competitor may, if they wish, make two separate entries in the same class provided that the models are entirely different. Re-entry with the same model is not permitted. Additional entries in different classes may also be purchased.

The number of flights will be five, or three if the weather forecast predicts windy conditions for all three days. All flights for any single entry must be flown on the same day. Scorecards must be handed in at the end of each day.

Timekeepers must be paid-up members of SAM 35.
