

Provisional Rules for the first running of the...

.....RUBBER RALLY.....

...at Buckminster, Sunday 20th October 2019

This is a ratio contest for almost any type of rubber powered model. Please see SAM Speaks March 2019 pp32-33 for further explanation.

Open to any insured BMFA member.

Models: Any rubber powered model of a recognised kit or plan, whether vintage, classic or contemporary. Wingspan, propellor size and motor tube length must be as per plan. Wingspan must be greater than 23”.

Entries: For the entry fee of £3, a competitor may have up to two entirely separate entries with two different designs. Only the higher scoring of the two entries will qualify for an award.

Procedure: Three flights per entry, hand launch, at any time during the stated flying period, which will be a minimum of five hours, beginning not before 10am. Attempt 15 seconds. Max 120 seconds. The duration in completed seconds will be divided by the wingspan to establish the score of each flight. That figure will be expressed to the nearest tenth. A competitor's final score will be the aggregate of the three flight scores, highest wins. In the event of a tie, a flyoff flight will be required with no maximum duration.

A bonus of 10% will be added to the flight duration of any cabin model (with undercarriage of two wheels or more.)

Awards: Engraved trophy to winner, certificates to second and third.
