

Earl Stahl Free Flight Competition,

Supplementary rules for 2018 onwards.

The following should be read in conjunction with the published Earl Stahl Rules (on this website) and apply to the 2018 onwards contests, after which the rules will be presented again in a single format.

The Eligibility definitions remain unchanged.

The Procedure for the event differs for 2017 as the contest, taking place at Old Warden on the Sunday of the Scale weekend, will be run concurrently with the Masefield Trophy. Consequently, the event will not be run as a mass launch event, but will be run in the conventional way with three rounds to a maximum that will be set on the day, taking into account weather conditions. Competitors may also enter the Masefield contest itself, as the model specification is similar, but “doubling up” of flights will not be permitted. Proxy flyers accepted.

In the event of a flyoff being necessary, there will be a simultaneous launch at a time selected by the CD, although separate timekeepers will still be required.

Entry Fee: £3.

Awards:

High Wing Trophy.

Low Wing Trophy.

Concours Trophy.

Trophies may be held for one year. To compete for the Concourse award, a framed, signed picture of Earl Stahl, competitors must produce their models (and plan, or reduced copy thereof) for judging at the beginning of the event. The criteria for assessment will be:

1) Accuracy to plan, 2) Finish 3) Detail, 4) Workmanship, each out of 10.
