Ajax and Achilles

Contest sponsored by the Cleemac Club. (see also "Speaks" November 2017, page 17)

Plans and kits of these two designs are readily available, they are quickly built and they can be flown on medium-sized fields such as Buckminster, where it is anticipated that this contest will normally be held.

Models must be built as per plan, with regard to the SAM 35 "Free Flight Competition Rules/Construction" with wheels of the same diameter as shown. Propellors may be of wood or plastic, with maximum diameters of 8" (Achilles) and 12" (Ajax.)

Models will be hand launched, and maxes (subject to conditions) will be 60 seconds (Achilles) and 75 seconds (Ajax.) Attempt time 15 seconds in each case.

Flights: Two flights to the maximum, then a third flight of unlimited duration (so that even if a competitor fails to max in an earlier flight, a good final flight could be enough to win.)

Awards: First in each class......Engraved trophy plus £12

Second in each class...... Certificate plus £8

Third in each class......Certificate plus £5

"Victor Ludorum" (for those who fly in both classes) Certificate.

(NB. The Victor Ludorum award will be presented to the competitor who beats the greatest number of fellow competitors in the two classes.)
