SAM35 Miss 35 Multi Task Competition.

SAM35 is running a new competition for the Miss35 Model Designed by Dave Banks and featured in Aeromodeller. The winner of the competition will be the competitor who accumulates the most points over a number of events. The winner will receive the prize of a SAM35 engine with the engine number 35. Rounds will be run at Spring Fly-in at Buckminster, the Mayfly at Old Warden, SAM35 Spring Fly-in at Buckminster with the final round at SAM35 Retro-Fest at Buckminster.

The competition is for radio controlled Miss 35 Models powered by a SAM35 engine fitted with a standard tank. Only rudder control is allowed. Choice of fuel is down to the pilot. Competitors gain points for two tasks which are undertaken in the same flight. The first task is duration the second task is spot landing. In each competition the points awarded for each task will depend on the number of competitors. If there are 10 competitors the pilot with the longest flight will gain 10 points and the pilot nearest the target will also gain 10 points. The next nearest will gain 9 points and so on. The pilot with the highest accumulated score from all competitions entered at the end of the season will win the SAM35 engine.
