May 10th to June 25th.

This is a stop-gap event to occupy the gap at the beginning of the 2021 season, as hopefully the country comes out of lockdown. If successful, however, it may appear on future calendars.

Models: Rubber powered cabin designs published during the vintage period, with wingspan less that 25" as measured with a tape measure from tip to tip. Scaling larger designs down to this size is not permitted. Undercarriage must be fitted as per plan, wheels close to the size on the plan. Prop size as shewn on the plan.

Entry: Write to the CD (below) for scorecards. Entry is free. After flying, please send cards at once to CD by post or scan and send by e-mail. Please state model(s) used on the card. Entrants do not have to be SAM 35 members, but must be BMFA insured and fully legal.

Classes: Class A: Overall

Class B: Best Achilles.

Competitors may enter both classes. Two models may be used in each class provided they qualify (An Achilles could be a back-up model in the "Open" class if the initial flight were with another design.)

Awards: Certificate for overall winner and "Best in Class."

Procedure: Three flights to a 90 second max. Attempt is 15 seconds: one attempt allowed per flight. Unlimited flyoff if appropriate. All three (or four) flights to be made on the same day at the same venue. Scorecard to be signed by BMFA member.

Dates: From May 10th to June 25th inclusive.
